Providing adequate access to nutritious foods is critically important. At BGCCl, 100% of Club members qualify for free or reduced lunch. Youth facing food insecurity leads to other challenges: poor mental and overall health, increased school absences, and increased behavioral problems. In conjunction with school provided meals, Club members receive three meals a day, including a hot dinner and snacks at Club, and food for their families over the weekend.

CREATING HOPE | \$1,000+

Sponsors field trip opportunities & transportation for one Club member for the entire year through annual gifts of \$1,000 or more.

In addition to providing safe transportation to Club for students who need it, Club members have access to a host of community immersion experiences throughout the year. Trips to lowa colleges, area zoos, parks, corporate partners and community centers like the Science Center and Botanical Center are all part of the Club experience.
